Signature Advantage and Signature Advantage Community Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare to Help pay for their Prescription Drug Costs (also called a Low-Income Subsidy)

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare. The amount of extra help you get will determine your total monthly plan premium as a member of our Plan.

This table shows what your monthly plan premium will be if you get extra help.

| Your level of Extra help | Monthly Premium for Signature Advantage or Signature Advantage Community |
|--------------------------|--|
| 100% | \$0 |
| 75% | \$7.40 |
| 50% | \$14.80 |
| 25% | \$22.20 |
