1: Covered Medications

BvD: Part B vs. Part D - This prescription drug may be covered under Medicare Part B or D depending upon the circumstances. Information may need to be submitted describing the use and setting of the drug to make this determination.

HRM: High Risk Medication - Prior authorization (PA) may be required for ages 65 and over.

PA1: Prior Authorization - You (or your physician) are required to get prior authorization before you fill your prescription for this drug. Without prior approval, we may not cover this drug.

PA2: Prior Authorization (New Starts Only) - You (or your physician) are required to get prior authorization before you fill your prescription for this drug unless you are a previous user of the drug. If you have a history of using this medication, you will not need prior authorization.

QL: Quantity Limit - There is a limit on the amount of this drug that is covered per prescription, or within a specific time frame.

ST: Step Therapy - In some cases, you may be required to first try certain drugs to treat your medical condition before we will cover another drug for that condition unless you are a previous user of the drug. If you have a history of using this medication, you will not need to try other medications first.
